

JULY 2018

Sun. July 01: Nigeria – Let us pray that the incessant killings of the citizenry in the country will cease and that the cord that binds the nation be not broken. Pray that the harmonious co-existence that once characterized Nigeria be revived.

Mon. July 02: Political Leaders – Pray that God in His mercy and grace would visit the political leaders in countries where there are violence and anarchy. Pray that also the people will become weary of evil and resort to God and His peace.

Tues. 03: West African Coverts – Ask God to grant courage and boldness to converts from other religions to remain steadfast in the face of persecution and oppositions. Pray that they will continue to walk on the narrow path, depending wholly on the Holy Spirit for strength and guidance to remain faithful.

Wed. July 04: Senegal Fulakunda – Ask God to raise powerful prayer efforts to break the forces of animism upon the Fulakunda. Pray that the Fulakunda believers would grow in Christ with as they study the Bible and stand firm in the Lord despite all odds.

Thurs. 5: Bagirmi of Chad – Majority of the Bagirmi people is Muslim, though some still practice traditional religion. Ask God to reveal His Son Jesus Christ to the people as the only source of peace and way to eternal life.

Fri. July 06: Bulgarian Jewish People – Pray that the spiritual eyes of this people group be opened for them to perceive Jesus as their Lord. Ask God to raise faithful labourers that will sacrificially reach out to them with His message of salvation.

Sat. July 07: Sephardic Jews of Greece – This group of people worship God but do not believe in the person of Jesus Christ. Pray that this people will have a revelation of Jesus Christ as the Son of God and not a blasphemer. Ask God to thrust out labourers to reach out to them with the love and light of Christ.

Sun. July 08: Israelis in Russia – Pray that these Israelis will begin to seek the Messiah even in the midst of opposition and that the Lord would in His mercy heal and salvage them. Ask God to do a thing in the land of Russia to draw both the Israelis and Russians massively to His Lordship.

Mon. July 09: Yemen – This is the poorest country in the Arab world. Pray for the transformation of families and against all forms of corruptions that characterise the country. Pray for more labourers who will live and serve sacrificially and lovingly among the people.

Tues. July 10: Indian – Pray for a spiritual awakening among the unreached people groups in this part of the world, especially on the Indian Ocean Island. Pray that the Lord would ignite a flame that no one can put out in this region.

Wed. July 11: South Asian – Pray for an increase in the number of labourers for this region and for the remaining unreached in the coastal and island regions to receive the light of God. Cry out for a spiritual breakthrough among these people groups.

Thurs. July 12: Kamuku Field – Pray that the Lord will prosper the efforts of the missionaries as they labour among this people in Niger State. Pray that the Lord will protect and grant them grace and wisdom for His work.

Fri. July 13: Bauchi Field – Pray that the power of false religions be broken for the light of Christ to penetrate into the land of Bauchi. Ask God to revive and burden the Christians living among them to reach out to the people.

Sat. July 14: Ahipawa Field – Pray for the growth of the young churches in the land and against the spirit of nominalism among the few believers. Ask God to strengthen the new converts in the face of persecution and to crumble the other religions building up there.

Sun. July 15: Buti-Ningi – Pray that the powers that prevent the Butawa people from accepting Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour be broken in this land. Ask God to convict the people and bring them to repentance and to a new life in Christ Jesus.

Mon. July 16: Fulani – Pray that God would expose the Fulani people to the truth and light of Jesus Christ; that there will be massive turn around for them to start seeking Jesus. Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide them unto the way of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Tues. July 17: International Students – Pray that the efforts of the International Students Ministries in Canada to reach out to the students be fruitful and that God would use those who have accepted Jesus to reach out to others in their home countries.

Wed. July 18: Refugee Highway Partnership – Pray God to bless and sustain the efforts of the Refugee Highway Partnership in meeting the physical and spiritual needs of displaced people in Toronto and other countries they are involved.

Thurs. July 19: Resources – Pray for resources for mission work around the globe. Ask God to raise people with willing and committed hearts to give their resources, talents, skills and time for the acceleration of the Great Commission.

Fri. July 20: Missionaries – Thank God for the increase in number among the Muslim background believers across West and Central Africa. Pray for continuous grace and protection for missionaries working among Islamised nations of Africa.

Sat. July 21: MSL Board and Council– Pray that God will grant the Board and Council members the grace to remain steadfast in spite of their numerous commitments. Also, ask God to grant them the wisdom to make decisions that will have positive influence on MSL operations.

Sun. July 22: MSL Kenya – Thank God for the progress of the work in Kenya, pray that He will continue to uphold and sustain both the staff members and the work. Also, pray that He will continue to guide and protect the leader as he coordinates the affairs of the Ministry there.

Mon. July 23: MSL International Office – Let us continue to pray for grace, safe trips and sustenance for the International Director as he directs the affairs of the International operations. Also, pray for God’s direction and wisdom for him to guide the Ministry aright.

Tues. July 24: MSL National Office – Thank God for His faithfulness upon the National operations of MSL, it has been Him all through. Pray for safety, wisdom, favour and open doors for Zonal Mobilisation Officers as they move across Nigeria expanding God’s Kingdom.

Wed. July 25: MSL Chapters – Appreciate God for obvious revival among the Chapters. Pray that they will keep the fire burning and for safety as they go visiting their various fields. Pray also for all that they need to sustain their vision.

Thurs. July 26: Partners and Supporters – We cannot thank God enough for the sacrificial partners and supporters He has blessed us with; continue to pray for safety, grace and God’s sustenance for them. Pray that they remain focused even in this end time.

Fri. July 27: Missionaries’ Children – Ask God to uphold these children as they grow in His fear and knowledge. Also, pray God to provide for their needs and that He will open doors of scholarship for them.

Sat. July 28: MSL Staff – Thank God for His faithfulness, sustenance, grace and mercy upon the lives of MSL staff members; it is all because of His love. Pray that His love and precept will continue to guide and rule over them as they serve Him in various ways.

Sun. July 29: The African Church – Thank God for sustaining the body of Christ in Africa. Please pray for revival upon the Church and for the move of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers to advance the gospel among the unreached nations.

Mon. July 30: Christian Homes – Praise God for the gift of beautiful families and homes and ask Him to restore Christian values. Pray for grace, steadfastness and safety for Christian homes, especially those in creative access places.

Tues. July 31: Bible Translation – Thank and praise God for the efforts of the Bible Translators globally. Pray for the protection of those working in hostile areas; pray also for inspiration and provision for the resources they need to serve God better.

AUGUST 2018

Wed. Aug. 01: Nigeria – Using Job 5:12–16 pray that God will expose and destroy every root of evil (wickedness, injustice, corruption in the country). Ask God to continue to rule over the affairs of Nigeria.

Thurs. Aug. 02: Uganda – Ask God to raise prayer teams to prepare the way for the gospel and to thrust labourers among the people of Uganda into missions. Pray that the evangelistic tools in Uganda will be used effectively for the glory of God.

Fri. Aug. 03: Coastlands of East Africa – Thank God for open doors in Islands and Coastlands in this region. Pray God to move men and women who will volunteer to take the gospel to these groups of unreached.

Sat. Aug. 04: The Mwali of Comoro – Pray that with the availability of the gospel in this place, the people will be open to accept the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Pray also for accuracy in the on-going Bible translation and safety for the translation team.

Sun. Aug. 05: The Sahel – Ask the Lord to raise intercessors for the total deliverance of Sahel people. The task of missions is capital intensive; ask God to raise people who would give cheerfully and sacrificially for mission work among the Sahel.

Mon. Aug. 06: Madagascar – Pray that the believers in Madagascar would focus on Jesus and that the young people there would hear and follow Jesus as He calls them. Pray for protection and provision for the missionaries labouring there.

Tues. Aug. 07: Punjabis in Mauritius – Thank God for those labouring among the Punjabis and pray that He will continue to sustain them in all areas. Ask God to reward their efforts with lasting fruits that will in turn reach out to their own people. Pray that the Sikhs of Mauritius will receive Jesus through divine encounters.

Wed. Aug. 08: Tanzania – Ask God to use Christians from other ethnic groups to bless the Muslims among them with the gospel. Pray for more Bible translations, that the translation teams would include Tanzanians and that the increase in Christian broadcast will yield lasting fruits.

Thurs. Aug. 09: Arabs of Kenya – Ask the Lord to raise labourers for this group of people and to create a hunger in their hearts for the knowledge of Jesus Christ. Pray that testimonies will abound as the people turn to Jesus in massive numbers.

Fri. Aug. 10: Gujarati in Mozambique – Ask God to humble the Gujarati businessmen to see their need for salvation that might in turn reach out to their families. Ask for protection, grace and boldness for the handful of Gujarati believers in the face of rejection by their people.

Sat. Aug. 11: The Kanuri People – Let us continue to pray for the restoration of peace in the land of Kanuri and for the protection of those displaced by crisis. Ask God to sustain and reward the efforts of the missionaries serving in Kanuri land.

Sun. Aug. 12: The Hausa – Pray that the Hausas mostly found in Nigeria and Niger might embrace the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Pray against every force or power hindering them from accepting Jesus Christ and that they wake up from the deceits of false religions.

Mon. Aug. 13: The Barma of Borno – Ask God to deliver Barma people from the powers and oppressions of darkness. Pray that the light of Christ will penetrate into this land and that the people be open and willing to receive the gospel.

Tues. Aug. 14: The Fulani – Ask God to provide an effective accessible formats for the Fulani people to receive the gospel. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the value of education to them. Pray for Christian teachers who would reach out to them with literacy and salvation message.

Wed. Aug. 15: The Pere of Adamawa – Making and sustaining converts have been difficult in this land; ask God to give the missionaries the key to the hearts of the people. Also ask Him to grant boldness to some of them who have heard the gospel enough to make decision for Christ.

Thurs. Aug. 16: The Kambari – Ask God to do a new thing in the land of Kambari in order to deliver the people from the bondage of the enemy. Ask Him to empower the Kambari believers to become witnesses of Jesus Christ unto their people.

Fri. Aug. 17: The Warji – Ask the Lord to raise intercessory teams to prepare the hearts of the people through worship and prayers. Pray for the salvation of the key leaders in Warji so that they can boldly preach the gospel to their families and people.

Sat. Aug. 18: The Urawa – They are purely animist and Muslims. Pray for the demonstration of Christ's power to these people so that they might believe and follow Jesus. Ask God to deliver them from every power that has held them bound for years and to thrust labourers into the land of Urawa.

Sun. Aug. 19: The Kotoko – Pray that the light of Jesus Christ will penetrate into the land of Kotoko despite every opposition. Pray also that the peoples' minds be open to receive and understand the gospel and that the seed already sown among them would grow and lead to conversions.

Mon. Aug. 20: Southern Nigeria – Pray that the many believers in this area will become faithful ambassadors of Christ. Pray against the spirit of materialism and mammon and ask the Lord to deliver the Church in this zone from nominalism and syncretism.

Tues. Aug. 21: Missionaries – Pray that missionaries will not give up but continue to preach without compromise or cultural bias. Pray for the manifestation of the Holy Spirit through signs and wonders in their lives and ministries.

Wed. Aug. 22: Muslims Globally – Another Ramadan (Muslim's fast) has begun; pray earnestly for Muslims globally. Ask God to reveal Himself to Muslims during this period. Pray

for huge harvest, especially from among the influential Muslim leaders, scholars, fundamentalists and so on.

Thurs. Aug. 23: MSL Chapters – Pray for continuous intimacy and focus for the Chapter members as they represent Christ in their adopted fields. Ask God to protect and bless them with their families and to grant them the grace to remain faithful to their calling.

Fri. Aug. 24: MSL New Frontiers – Thank God for how He has been using this platform to draw youths closer to Christ and to envision them for missions. Please pray for the grace and every other resource needed to run this arm of the Ministry effectively.

Sat. Aug. 25: MSL Management – Pray that the Management team will continue to lead the members of this Ministry in the fear and way of the Lord. Ask God to grant them the grace, wisdom, knowledge and understanding that they need to exhibit Christ-like leadership.

Sun. Aug. 26: MSL Staff – Pray that every staff will walk and work closely with God and do just as He would command. Ask God to grant to them every grace, wisdom and knowledge that they need to serve Him cheerfully and better.

Mon. Aug. 27: MSL Mobilisation Efforts – Thank God for the several safe trips He has been granting the Mobilisation Officers. Let us continue to pray for good health for them and their families, and for God's protection and provision as they serve Him.

Tues. Aug. 28: The Universal Church – Pray that the universal Church will practically emphasise and focus on outreaches, evangelism, missions and community engagement with the gospel of Christ. Pray that the Church will realise that these responsibilities are mandatory for her.

Wed. Aug. 29: Nigerian Church – Pray that God will bless Nigeria with leaders who are truly called and deeply taught in the Scriptures; people who are willing to suffer deprivation, scorn and even the risk of death. Pray for leaders who are willing to bear burdens and responsibility of leadership for the sake of Christ.

Thurs. Aug. 30: Christian Homes – Let us continue to pray that Christian homes will be what the Lord expects them to be, homes where the love and fear of God are the ultimate. Pray that God will give us peaceful homes with godly children especially in Nigeria.

Fri. Aug. 31: Emigration and Human trafficking – Living in Europe at all cost now seems to be the means to a better life; the wicked ones profit from this desperation, ruining so many lives and families. Ask God to bring universal justice and righteousness to eradicate such dreams and risky endeavours.

SEPTEMBER 2018

Sat. Sept. 01: Nigeria – Nigeria is richly blessed, yet this is not reflected in the physical lives of the majority of the citizens. Pray for a change of heart for those managing the resources; asking God to deliver everyone involved from greed.

Sun. Sept. 02: Togo – Ask God to grant the Christians in Togo the strength and passion for evangelism and pray for the growth and increase of mature believers. Ask God to crumble the walls of Islam in Togo.

Mon. Sept. 03: South Africa – Thank God for the Church and missions movement in South Africa. Moral absolutes no longer hold in the nation; ask God to raise prophetic voices for the South African Church. Pray that the leadership of the country will direct the people with godly fear and wisdom.

Tues. Sept. 04: Cote D'Ivoire – Pray against all the strongholds preventing massive repentance in the land. Pray also that the Church would rise up to the challenge of the Islamised northern part of the country.

Wed. Sept. 05: Mozambique – Thank God for the freedom in the land, pray that it will lead to the expression of true Christian faith. Pray that the Church will grow spiritually to match the numerical growth and pray that the believers will abide.

Thurs. Sept. 06: Chad – To God be the glory; many unreached peoples are hearing the gospel for the first time in the land. Pray that Christians might maximise the opportunities of the current existence of freedom and that the government will be honest and committed to all the citizens of Chad.

Fri. Sept. 07: China – Pray that all the followers of Christ working in the state structures might be good ambassadors and a redemptive force, serving faultlessly within the government. Pray that the Church remains vibrant and that the cutting edge be not blunt even in the midst of persecution or oppositions.

Sat. Sept. 08: Asia – Thank God for the continuous remarkable Church growth in Asia, many unreached peoples are experiencing breakthroughs and spiritual fruits. The growth of MBBs is unprecedented. Ask God to grant them the grace and courage to remain faithful in the face of persecution. Pray for boldness and wisdom for the MBBs to preach the good news to others.

Sun. Sept. 09: The Americas – Thank God for the political stability and a steady shift towards democratic structures in American government and for the many who are encountering Jesus on personal basis. Pray for effective and viable policies that would draw the people closer to God. Ask God to move in such a way as to prevent what ever will obstruct the godly and smooth running of the government.

Mon. Sept. 10: Europe – Many of the youths grow up in an environment devoid of Christian witness and values and are now the new challenges facing Europe. Pray for the formation of

mission networks that will witness to the youths in Europe effectively. Pray also that God would miraculously close up the Christian generation gap in the continent.

Tues. Sept. 11: Afghanistan – Let us thank God for what He is doing in this land and for the efforts of the Christian media there. Pray against every force or stronghold binding the people and that they will be free from fear and prejudice. Pray for courage and wisdom on how best to express the love of Christ to the people and for the manifestation of spiritual breakthrough among them.

Wed. Sept. 12: The Indians of Fiji – They are the largest unreached people group in the Pacific. Pray for strategic and effective evangelisation of these groups of Muslims and Hindus. Pray for open doors and for labourers who will passionately volunteer to serve among them.

Thurs. Sept. 13: Saudi Arabia – Ask God to grant Saudi Believers courage and wisdom on how best to share the love of Jesus with their families. Pray for grace and boldness for them to remain in good relationships with their families. Pray for miraculous revelation of Jesus to couples in Saudi.

Fri. Sept. 14: NEMA – Ask the Lord to protect and sustain NEMA member agencies as well as other team of labourers in hostile areas. Pray the Lord of the harvest to equip them with all the grace, knowledge and wisdom needed to bring in sheaves with joy.

Sat. Sept. 15: Missionaries – Pray that missionaries in various fields and regions will identify and learn the heart languages of the people they reach out to. Pray that those who learn the Bible orally will be greatly inspired to accept Jesus as they relate with the missionaries.

Sun. Sept. 16: The Bauchi – Thank God for extending His grace and love to the people of Bauchi. Ask God to lift up the gates and to open the everlasting doors for Christ to enter. Ask the Holy Spirit to convict the people and liberate them from the fear of men and persecution.

Mon. Sept. 17: The Egbira – Pray against the grip and influence of the false religion upon the lives of this people; that God will cause them to become dissatisfied with the deceit of the religion. Ask God to raise more prayer force for this land and more labourers to work among them.

Tues. Sept. 18: The Fulani – Pray that the stronghold of Islam be broken among the Fulani people all over and ask God to cause the light of Jesus Christ to shine in their hearts. Pray God to strengthen the Fulani Christian believers in order to reach out to their people.

Wed. Sept. 19: The Miyawa – The Miyawa people are at a cross road with the entrance of both Christianity and Islam at the same time in their land. Pray for knowledge and wisdom for the missionaries on how best to reach out to them effectively and that God should avert the plans of the Muslims to shortly islamise the people.

Thurs. Sept. 20: Bashar of Plateau – Pray for dissatisfaction with Islam among this people that will cause them to start seeking for the Truth and Light. Pray that Jesus be revealed to them divinely, especially to their teachers and that their hearts be open to receive Him.

Fri. Sept. 21: Worldwide Day of Peace – Thank God for the gift of the International Day of Peace. Pray that the world will indeed seek Jesus Christ who is the giver of peace to know and have the desired peace. Pray also that God will reveal Christ to as many as seek peace all over the world.

Sat. Sept. 22: Omega2Project – Thank God for the progress of this vision of the Foursquare Church Asokoro; appreciate him for the results it is yielding across the nation and beyond. Pray for the grace and blessing of God upon them and that this vision will continue to expand the gospel.

Sun. Sept. 23: MSL – Thank God for MSL Stakeholders and for the role they are playing in advancing the Kingdom through MSL vision. Pray that God will continue to renew their zeal, passion and commitment to serve Him better in the years ahead. Pray also for protection and provision for them and their family members.

Mon. Sept. 24: Mobilization Officers – Ask the Lord to open doors of ministry to them in their various States of coverage. Pray that He will grant them access to Church leaders and individual Christians that will support missions with their lives and resources.

Tues. Sept. 25: MSL National Office – There is need for staff in the different departments of the Ministry. Plead with God to thrust out Christians who will serve on the platform of MSL voluntarily and passionately; every profession and skill is very needful in the Ministry.

Wed. Sept. 26: MSL Chapters – Pray that the on-going revival in the Chapters would sweep across them all and that their later glory will surpass the former. Pray for grace and strength for them to continue to do exploit for the Kingdom.

Thurs. Sept. 27: Nigerian Church – Ask God to grant the leader grace and the wisdom to prevent denominationalism and moral decay. Pray that every church must serve to develop believers, draw in the unreached and to glorify God in all aspect

Fri. Sept. 28: Universal Church – Discipleship is one of the challenges facing the Church today especially in regions where the Church is growing in number. Ask God to teach the leaders how best to shape the worldview and lifestyle of members biblically in order to produce mature and lasting Christians.

Sat. Sept. 29: Families and Partners – Pray that God will continue to protect and sustain our beloved ones. Pray for His continuous guidance upon them and for increase in every area of their lives, especially in their relationships with Him.

Sun. Sept. 30: International Students – Globally, Australia and New Zealand house the largest number of them. Pray that the Church will develop both vision and strategy on how to harness this group of future leaders who are often very open to the gospel. Ask God to provide free access for Christian missions in these areas.

OCTOBER 2018

Mon. Oct. 01: Nigeria – Many Nigerian youths are dying daily as they embark on suicidal trips to other lands in search for a better life. Plead with God to have mercy and attend to the plights of the citizens of this nation, especially the youths who faced with unemployment.

Tues. Oct. 02: Yao of Malawi – Pray that Yao Muslims would receive a revelation of the Lord Jesus that would open them to hear the gospel and to embrace Jesus as Saviour. Pray for fruits for those labouring among them and for the indigenous believers to take up the challenge of discipleship.

Wed. Oct. 03: Rwanda – Pray for the Church in Rwanda that lost credibility by failing to oppose evil adequately and to speak against the ethnic hatred that led to the massacre. Pray for a revival, characterised by repentance, love and Christ-centred Church in Rwanda. Ask God to root out those who would want to destabilise this nation again.

Thurs. Oct. 04: Djibouti – Pray that the few Djibouti believers will remain steadfast in following Jesus even in the face of severe persecution. Pray God to send long-term workers who will witness Christ to the people effectively and to raise strong Christian leaders from the Somali and Afar believers of Djibouti.

Fri. Oct. 05: Senegal – The youths of Senegal face the challenge of unemployment, poor economic conditions and lack of hope. Pray that God will restore their hope and direct them to make good use of their potentials. Ask God to open more clubs to serve as effective tools to reach out to them.

Sat. Oct. 06: Gambia – Pray that the unreached people groups in Gambia will encounter Christ and that the nominal Christians may discover genuine life in Christ Jesus. Pray also that those reaching out to them will be wise, effective and fruitful as they labour.

Sun. Oct. 07: Botswana – A good number of the people are Christians just by name. Pray for revival among the protestant churches and among the Christians generally and for a reversal of the moral decline in Botswana. Ask God to sustain the open doors and the holistic ministries in the land.

Mon. Oct. 08: Hindus of Mauritius – Thank God for what He is doing among this group of people. Ask Him to draw many more to His loving arms and pray that they will recognise the greatness of God and tell of His great works to others. Pray for the provision and distribution of appropriate Christian literature.

Tues. Oct. 09: United Kingdom – Pray for national repentance and restoration of spiritual vibrancy for Great Britain and that Christianity will recover its confidence in the gospel. Pray to stop the advance of Islam and for greater opportunity to witness to the Muslims.

Wed. Oct. 10: Jordan – In the midst of religious pressure or tension, religious freedom could be casualty. Pray for grace, strength and boldness for the converts in Jordan as they face pressures from families, work places and society. Pray for Christians to stay put in Jordan and for freedom to preach the gospel.

Thurs. Oct. 11: Bangladesh – Ask God to awaken the Church of Christ in Bangladesh. Pray for unity of spirit and purpose among the members and against nominalism in the Church. Pray also for effective programmes on literacy training with Scriptures and for initiative in sharing the Bible through story telling.

Fri. Oct. 12: Japan – Pray for the move of the Holy Spirit among the Japanese, to open their eyes to the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pray for a decisive breakthrough that will produce mature and abiding fruits and that the Spirit of God will overrule the spirit of delusion in the lives of the Japanese.

Sat. Oct. 13: Iran – Pray that the Church of Christ will continue to multiply and mature even in the midst of persecution. Pray that those facing pressure and hopelessness will encounter Christ to receive freedom and hope. Pray also for light in the nominal Church and that members will have the burden and boldness to reach out to their neighbours.

Sun. Oct. 14: Iraq – Pray for grace, boldness and peace in the face of persecution for the very few believers in Iraq. Pray also for the spread of the gospel all through the land and for the transformation of the nation through God's love and justice.

Mon. Oct. 15: United Arab Emirate – With the UAE becoming a liberal state, pray that the strongholds of false religions in the Emirate will crumble. Ask God to protect and grant wisdom to the foreign Christians in the land on how best to witness to the people.

Tues. Oct. 16: NEMA: Pray for spiritual awakening among the member agencies of NEMA. Pray for effective strategies and means to revive them especially at the Zonal levels and on how to attract new mission minded churches to join NEMA.

Wed. Oct. 17: The Kakanda – Ask God to raise prayer teams to break the soil through worship and intercession. Pray that Jesus Christ will reveal Himself to the people and that God will manifest in a way that will bring forth a viable and vibrant Church in the land of Kakanda.

Thurs. Oct. 18: The Kaivi (Kalbi) – Pray that the blood of Jesus Christ will avail for this group of people and that Jesus will shine His light to liberate them from false religions. Ask God to burden souls to stand in the gap and raise labourers to reach out to them.

Fri. Oct. 19: The Gerawa – Pray against the hostility of the people towards Christianity and for the salvation of their prominent leaders as this would spread the gospel faster in the land. Pray also against the fear of persecution and that the people will be bold enough to accept Jesus as Lord.

Sat. Oct. 20: The Isawa – Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the whole truth about Jesus Christ to this people as they seek Him through other religions and to convict them to worship Him. Ask God to burden more labourers to serve among the Isawa people.

Sun. Oct. 21: The Jara – Pray against the strongholds of false religions among this people and that the light of Jesus will shine both in their hearts and in the land. Pray that the churches in this area will develop the burden to reach out to the people with the gospel in love.

Mon. Oct. 22: The Laru – Pray that the blood of Jesus Christ will speak for Laru people and that God will raise people that will breakthrough the land with prayers. Pray also that the deceit of Islam be exposed to them and that God will raise people with passion to engage them with the good news.

Tues. Oct. 23: Missionary Children – Pray that God would provide the spiritual, academic and material needs of these children; ask Him to sustain them in all areas. Pray that they would be epitomes of Minister's children, honouring God with their lives.

Wed. Oct. 24: MSL Chapters – Pray for open doors for members to establish more Chapters in the Southern part of the country and that God will thrust out men and women who are ready to be part of this arm of MSL.

Thurs. Oct. 25: New Frontiers – Pray that the seeds being sown in the lives of youths will grow to produce abiding fruits of righteousness and for more labourers to join the force. Continue to pray for God's grace, knowledge and safety for the Officer in charge.

Fri. Oct. 26: MSL UK and USA – Pray that the MSL movements in UK and USA will continue to yield good fruits. Ask God to bless and sustain the members as they stand with the frontier mission workers.

Sat. Oct. 27: MSL Kenya – Pray for Successful establishment of Mission Supporters League in Uganda and Rwanda as the Coordinator plans to penetrate into these countries soon. Pray for God's safety and enablement for him as he travels across East and North Africa.

Sun. Oct. 28: Christian Homes – Let us continue to pray that Christian parents will have all that it takes to instil moral values in the lives of their children. Pray also that the love of Christ will be the hallmark of every Christian home.

Mon. Oct. 29: The Nigerian Church – Pray for leaders who can expound the Scriptures accurately and effectively. Pray also for new methods and means of developing and multiplying godly-trained, effective and abiding leaders, especially for a country like Nigeria with rapid church growth

Tues. Oct. 30: The Universal Church – The issue of prosperity theology has become a universal challenge; pray that every church, leader and individual will be burdened with the plight of the lost souls and that righteousness and sanctification will again overrule in the body of Christ.

Wed. Oct. 31: FOCUS Delegates – Pray that students and associates who indicated interest to be involved in missions support will follow through their commitments and that God will grant them grace and resources to do so.

NOVEMBER 2018

Thurs. Nov. 01: Nigeria – Thank God for His love and special interest in Nigeria as a nation. Pray that the people of this country will fulfil God's agenda by being channels of blessing to other nations of the earth spiritually and otherwise.

Fri. Nov. 02: Guinea Bissau – Pray that God will raise tent-making Missionaries from Nigeria to tackle some of the challenges in this land. Ask God to ignite the indigenous Church to reach out to the leaders and the people of the land for Christ.

Sat. Nov. 03: Ethiopia – Ask the Holy Spirit to revitalise the ancient Ethiopian Church with her biblical heritage and spiritual legacy. Pray for faithful Christian teachers that will mentor the young people effectively. Ask God to change the story of the Ethiopians to a positive one.

Sun. Nov. 4: Benin Republic – Ask God to raise people who will engage the Church in Benin in discipleship and to thrust out ministers to reach out to the large number of youths in the country. Pray God to continue to deliver the people from the spirit of Voodoo.

Mon. Nov. 5: Morocco – Pray for grace and boldness for the Church to continue to preach Jesus as Lord even in tough times. Ask God to manifest His glory to the people of Morocco and to raise indigenous leaders to over see the under ground Church in the land.

Tues. Nov. 6: Democratic Republic of Congo – Pray that the Holy Spirit will sweep away every false belief in the land. Pray for the restoration of Christian training centres and that godly values and principles be established in them. Pray for strength and courage for the missionaries serving in Congo.

Wed. Nov. 7: Central African Republic – Pray for greater involvement of the church leaders in church planting movement and that they will send members with vision and passion to be trained as missionaries. Pray for proper coordination of effective Christian radio programmes in this region.

Thurs. Nov. 8: Algeria – Thank God for the new fellowships propping up all over the country and for the commitment of the Berber believers in reaching out to the Arab areas. Pray that the conversion of the Berber people will continue to spread, deepen and extent to others. Pray God to destroy every force fighting against the young growing Church in Algeria.

Fri. Nov. 9: Qatar – Pray for the birth of a Qatari Church and that Qataris at home and abroad would get to know about Jesus Christ. Pray that Christians would occupy important positions in order to have international kingdom presence in Qatar and for opportunities to share with non-Christian groups in the country.

Sat. Nov. 10: Oman – Thank God for the opportunity for residents to practice their faith and for the few Omanis who are accepting the Lordship of Christ. Pray for effective witnessing to the people and that mission-minded Christians will be effective and fruitful in planting, watering and reaping the harvest.

Sun. Nov. 11: Saudi Arabia – Thank God for the way He is revealing Himself to increasing number of them. Pray for a spiritual breakthrough to shake Mecca and to establish Christ's Lordship there. Ask God for the miracle of legalising Christianity in Saudi and pray safe meetings and access to God' word for the believers.

Mon. Nov. 12: Pakistan – The Church though nominal and immature continues to grow in the face of oppositions. Ask God to raise humble and committed Christian leaders with a passion to serve the Church and to bless and improve the lives of the Christians who are mostly second-class citizens of Saudi.

Tues. Nov. 13: Kuwait – Pray that the indigenes who hear the gospel would respond positively despite pressure from both families and culture. Pray also that Kuwait leaders and people would embrace Christ as their Lord and Saviour and for open doors among the unengaged unreached people of **Bedouin** (stateless Arabs).

Wed. Nov. 14: Israel – Pray that the Jews in a large number, especially their leaders will understand and embrace the gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray for the widespread and distribution of Christian materials and for effective follow-up of enquiries generated by the materials.

Thurs. Nov. 15: Southern Russia – Pray against the plans to Islamise this area and that the whole region will experience peace, progress and freedom of religion. Pray that the efforts of the believers who are collaborating to extend the love of Christ in this region will yield multiple fruits and that nothing would hinder it.

Fri. Nov. 16: NEMA: Pray for safe trips as they travel for various training programmes and mobilization activities. Pray that all member agencies will experience growth under the spirit of this national association and for harmonious co-existence among them.

Sat. Nov. 17: Minister's Children – Pray for protection and provision for all their needs. Pray that they will grow to flourish in the things of the Lord, occupying and advancing the Kingdom of God in their generation. Pray also for good successes in their academic endeavours.

Sun. Nov. 18: The Lopa – Pray that God will stop the spread of Islam among this people group and deliver the youths from the enticement of Muslims. Ask God to shine His light in the land and to raise people with burden to both pray and reach out to Lopa people.

Mon. Nov. 19: The Gwadara – Pray for this group of people to understand the supremacy of Jesus Christ and to embrace Him as their Lord and Saviour. Pray against the ethnic crisis in the area and for more missionaries with burden for the people.

Tues. Nov. 20: Kupa field – Appreciate God for His faithfulness in this field and ask Him to reward His labourers there with a vibrant indigenous Church. Pray that the Christians living in Kupa land will exhibit the life of Christ for the indigenes to emulate.

Wed. Nov. 21: Kusasi/Frafra People – Pray the Lord to strengthen, encourage and provide for the missionaries there and to restore the health of their son. Pray for a massive harvest of souls among this group of people for the Kingdom.

Thurs. Nov. 22: The Ganagana – Ask God to reveal Himself to them, especially to family heads and other leaders. Pray for a change for those who have heard the gospel and that God will burden agencies and missionaries to target the people.

Fri. Nov. 23: Christian Missionary Foundation – Pray for encouragement and grace for the missionaries as they continue to serve God. Ask God to break the yoke of other religions and liberate them, especially as they fast this time. Pray that God's understanding will flood their hearts.

Sat. Nov. 24: El-Rehoboth M2414 – Thank God for the privilege given to this movement to serve the body of Christ. Pray that Christ-like leadership and development that will influence the Church positively will emerge through their Network.

Sun. Nov. 25: CRUDAN & RURCON – Thank God for the efforts of CRUDAN and RURCON in the development of Christians from all walks of life for the expansion of the Kingdom. Pray that God will increase their knowledge and wisdom as they continue to transform lives.

Mon. Nov. 26: MSL International Office – Thank God for the vision of MSL Centre, pray that God will bring it to fulfilment. Pray for God’s wisdom and direction for the International Director as he pilots this aspect and for God’ favour concerning this project.

Tues. Nov. 27: MSL Staff – Pray for grace, fruitfulness and safety as staff members go about their ministerial responsibilities. Ask the Lord to raise partners for the payment of their rents and for their upkeep.

Wed. Nov. 28: Friends and Partners – Thank God for the gift of faithful partners and friends who have been so committed to fulfilling the Great Commission. Pray that their relationship with God will remain solid and that He will continue to sustain them and their family members in all areas.

Thurs. Nov. 29: MSL Board and Council – Thank God for the steadfastness of these members. Ask God to provide all that they need to remain focused and to continue giving godly counsels as they serve Him in various ways and places.

Fri. Nov. 30: The Universal Church – Pray for oneness in the Body of Christ and pull down the stronghold of denominationalism. Pray that the members will use their gifts, strength and resources for the edification of one another despite the differences. Pray God to restore the Church to attain the full stature of Christ.

DECEMBER 2018

Sat. Dec. 01: Nigeria – Pray ahead of the 2019 general elections in Nigeria that God will give the nation leaders who would uphold righteousness and justice. Ask God to grant Nigeria a fair and blood free elections to His glory and to the joy of the people.

Sun. Dec. 02: States of India – Pull down the strongholds of other religions over all the States of India under bondage and declare freedom to all the captives. Nullify the powers that defile Jesus Christ as the Lord and Saviour of the whole world. Plead with God to demonstrate His powerful passion and love in these States.

Mon. Dec. 03: Malaysia – Pray that the Christian community will continue to possess the liberty to practice, profess and propagate their faith amid the discrimination and intimidation rising from

the current Islamisation process. Pray, godly leadership, Christian workers and for unity among Christians in the land.

Tues. Dec. 04: Cambodia – Thank God for the open doors for ministry despite some limitations. Pray for the steady growth of the Church among the Khmer people and that, they will remain aflame for God with a passion for the souls of their fellow citizens. Pray for wisdom and sensitivity for Christians ministering to the physical needs of the people.

Wed. Dec. 05: Indonesia – Pray against the plans of the enemy to dominate this land by increasing their population and by eradicating the Christians. Pray for the repentance of households as a unit and for them to find healthy express of faith within their communities and culture.

Thurs. Dec. 06: North Korea – This region is seemingly the most difficult place to be a Christian (anything about Christ mentioned or seen is punishable by death). Pray that both the indigenous and expatriate Christians would persevere in the face of difficult environment and oppositions. Ask God to encounter their leaders just as He encountered Saul.

Fri. Dec. 07: Libya – Pray that portion of believers in Libya might have a powerful Spiritual influence on Libyans and fellow migrants. Pray for them to stand firm in faith and to find spiritual edifying relationships. Pray also for greater religious freedom for more to hear the gospel and to accept Jesus Christ.

Sat. Dec. 08: Syria – Pray that the believers might discover the zeal and faith of the NT Church in Antioch and gain a deep desire to grow in godliness and outreach. Pray that God would manifest His love among these groups, the Sunni Arabs, the Druze, the Alawites, the Kurds and the Bedouin. Pray also for people with passion to stand in the gap and to reach out to them.

Sun. Dec. 09: Horn of Africa – Thank God for what He is doing in this region and pray for more labourers to reach out to the unreached people groups there. Pray that Christians working there would find lasting solutions to the frequent droughts in the region.

Mon. Dec. 10: Malawi: Ask to God to stir up the hearts of believers in Malawi to reach out to the Indians, Chinese and other non-Christian groups among them. Ask God to grant them the boldness, wisdom and the best ways to reach out to these groups within their reach.

Tues. Dec. 11: Niger – believers in Niger face isolation, pray for formation of groups for those who need fellowship with other Christians. Pray for unity among the believers and for effective leadership training for new leaders and those currently in pastoral work. Ask God to sustain the missionaries labouring in Niger.

Wed. Dec. 12: Egypt – Pray for grace for every Christians to stand firm in their faith through every circumstance. Pray for boldness, wisdom and sensitivity for them to witness through their

lives and in words if opportune. Pray for the wider availability and distribution of Jesus Film in Arabic. Ask God to exhibit His power in Egypt.

Thurs. Dec. 13: Mali – Thank God for the stability of Christianity in Mali, pray that He would continue to uphold it. Pray for the multiplication of indigenous missionaries and for good collaboration with foreign missions in the land. Pray for more labourers in the areas of church planting, evangelism and social development among the people.

Fri. Dec. 14: Guinea Conakry – Pray for close relationship between mission agencies and national churches. Pray that believers would grow in perseverance and that young believers will stand firm in their faith. Pray that the Jesus film will have lasting effect and that it would reach out to more people.

Sat. Dec. 15: Nigerian Youths – Pray for revival among youths and students in Nigeria. Ask God to raise a fresh band of young work force for the harvest fields from different campuses. Pray against every device of Satan to turn the attention of campus fellowships from genuine discipleship and missions.

Sun. Dec. 16: Northern Nigeria – Ask God to dislodge the evil of Boko-Haram from this part of the country and to create an atmosphere conducive for missions among the people. Ask God to encourage the few Christians there to remain faithful to their faith and bold to evangelize their people.

Mon. Dec. 17: NEMA – Pray for Global peace and security and ask God to continue to comfort grieving families who lost their loved ones, friends and relatives in war, violence and religious crises. Pray specifically for Christians in the vision 5015 nations that God will strengthen them to stay on and persevere in the face of persecution.

Tues. Dec. 18: Missionaries' Children – The life of missionary children can be hectic; movements of their parents from one place to another and financial constraints often affect their social and academic growth. Pray God to watch over these children and guide their parents to strike a balance between ministry and family lives.

Wed. Dec. 19: Health Challenges – Some missionaries are physically sick while others are traumatised due to various family and ministerial challenges. Pray that God will send the Sun of Righteousness with healing in His wings to as many that are currently facing challenges.

Thurs. Dec. 20: The Fulani – Thank God for those He has given new minds, hearts and Spirit, pray that they will abide. Ask the Lord to move the hearts of believers unto love towards the Fulani people and trust the Lord to save them. Pray that powers of sorcery and witchcraft will disappoint them, causing them to behold the Almighty God.

Fri. Dec. 21: Dir people: Pray that the indigenous believers will actively evangelise their people. Pray for wisdom and grace for the missionaries to effectively disciple new believers and that God will continue to sustain them and the converts even in difficult times.

Sat. Dec. 22: Arigida Field – Thank God for the new converts in this field, pray that they remain firm even in the face of oppositions. Pray for God’s grace and provision for the missionaries and ask Him to reward them with more lasting fruits in this field.

Sun. Dec. 23: Boko Field – Pray for divine health, grace and favour for the missionaries working in this field and that God will increase them in wisdom, knowledge and understanding as they serve Him and that He would reward them with lasting fruits.

Mon. Dec. 24: Maiduguri – Pray that the indigenes of this city will bow to the Lordship of Jesus Christ and that as they pray daily to an unknown God, Christ would reveal Himself to them as the only Way, the Truth and the Life. Ask God to halt the activities of the evil ones in this region.

Tues. Dec. 25: Omega2 Project – Thank God for the team members of this project. Pray that they shall continue to enjoy team spirit as they serve the interest of God. Pray for God’s direction, safety and sustenance in all their ways, trips and livelihood.

Wed. Dec. 26: MSL Mobilization Efforts: Praise God for the lives of MSL Mobilization Officers and for the successes recorded so far. Pray God to increase their passion for His work and to protect, strengthen and provide all that they need to serve Him better.

Thurs. Dec. 27: MSL National Office – The National Office is in need of skilled personnel who are willing to serve the Lord with their talents in areas such as Accounting, Graphic Designing, ICT, Media, Publishing (editing and proofreading), Administration and so on. Please pray God to send the right people to the Ministry.

Fri. Dec. 28: MSL New Frontiers – Pray that God would raise partners to enhance the capacity for mobilising youths and for success in all the out-lined programmes of the Officer. Continue to pray for safety as they travel in the cause of ministry.

Sat. Dec. 29: Chapters and Supporters – Thank God for the efforts of the Chapters to advance God’s Kingdom among the unreached. Ask God to release heaven’s resources in abundance for all God’s people who are supporting various mission endeavours and pray for safety for them all.

Sun. Dec. 30: : Christian Professionals – Pray that God will burden the hearts of more Christian professionals to get involved in the work of reaching the unreached nations and that many will be moved to serve God with their professions in various strategic ways.

Mon. Dec. 31: Intercessors – Pray for yourself as an intercessor that your fire will not burn out and for the grace to make the necessary sacrifices that come with standing in the gap for others.

Ask God to raise more intercessors that are fervent for the unreached people. Appreciate God for bringing us to the end of the year and ask Him to make you a better servant of His next year!
